This will be held **today** at 11.45am following the Eucharist at St Stephen & St Agnes Church. Churchwardens and PCC members will be elected at this meeting and there will be a review of 2025 with an opportunity to ask questions. This year, there are also elections to Deanery Synod. The meeting should last no longer than an hour and is open to all those on the Electoral Roll. The APCM is an important part of governance in the Church of England and all parishes are required to hold a meeting before **31st May** each year. Please make every effort to attend.

Churchwardens are elected each year to our four churches. Nominations must be received prior to the start of the APCM. It is anticipated that there will be two vacancies in this role at Windsor Parish Church of St John the Baptist.
