Gift Aid Officer

The PCC need to appoint someone to assist with Gift Aid. This involves collating the information and submitting the claims to HMRC. It is a substantially less onerous task than previously as many of our regular donors give via the Parish Giving Scheme (PGS). However there remains a need for a GA officer to deal with giving which is not through PGS (eg giving using envelopes and small cash donations).
